Scott Kennedy serves as the Modernization and Infrastructure director for PanTeXas Deterrence, LLC, the management and operating contractor of the Pantex Plant in Amarillo, Texas. He returned to Pantex in 2024.

In this role, Kennedy directs the management systems supporting site Infrastructure and Modernization, including Project Management and execution, Maintenance, and Construction.
