Jason Trichel serves as the Internal Audit, Ethics and Employee Concerns senior director for PanTeXas Deterrence, LLC, the management and operating contractor for the Pantex Plant in Amarillo, Texas. He joined Pantex in 2024.

In this role, Trichel leads Internal Audit, which provides an independent assurance and advisory function to management, and helps PXD accomplish its objectives by bringing a systematic, disciplined approach to evaluate and improve the effectiveness of the risk management, control, and governance process.
