Proposed Action Title: Zone 4 Restroom Replacement

Program or Field Office: NNSA Production Office (Pantex)

Location(s) (City/County/State): Amarillo, Carson, Texas

Proposed Action Description:

The purpose of this project would be to replace the aging restroom in Zone 4, and would include the demolition and disposal of the existing restroom with installation and operation of a new modular restroom at the same location. The project would remove and dispose of the existing concrete foundation and associated sidewalks. Any Class II waste from demolition or construction going to the Pantex Construction landfill or the Environmental Remediation landfill will meet the Waste Acceptance Criteria (HNDBK-0023) prior to disposal at these facilities. Any Class II waste not meeting the criteria established for either onsite landfill would require offsite transportation for disposal. The new 24-ft. x 30-ft. modular restroom would come from the factory complete with all fixtures and the interior and exterior pre-finished.
